Frequently Asked Questions

1. Q: If I completed a course in the 8th grade (like Algebra I or Spanish I), can I write it down and does it count for the “a-g requirements?”

A: Yes.

2. Q: Can my “g” requirement be a combination of two different semester-long classes?

A: Yes. (*Example: Computer Programming and Government*)

3. Q: If I got a ‘D’ only one semester of a year-long course, will it count for “a-g?”

A: No. You have to re-take that semester in summer school, adult Ed, or here.
