4.	Teaching And Technology	In the hands of a creative teacher, computers can greatly enhance student learning and motivation.	Designed lesson plans and taught 3 rd graders how to use computers to write stories.
5.	Law Enforcement	The employment of K-9 units on campuses violates students' rights against unlawful search and seizure.	Arranged for on-campus demonstration.
6.	Music	Writing the score for a musical not only requires knowledge of instrumentation, but also requires an intricate knowledge of the script and the playwright's intent.	Wrote a score (music and lyrics) for a musical and performed the musical for an audience
7.	Science	Aspirin can have a positive effect on a variety of ailments and diseases other than body aches with which it is most closely associated.	Conducted an experiment to see what affect aspirin has on a variety of ailments.
8.	Special Education	The use of facilitated communication is especially effective among the autistic population.	Provided an in-service for school faculty on facilitated communication
9.	Self Protection	Women who enroll in self-defense are better able to fend off a rape attack.	Planned and hosted pre-prom rape prevention assemblies
10.	Art	New and alternative art forms such as bike bonding should be accepted and appreciated by mainstream society.	"Bonded" a bike frame in a low rider style and then entered bike frame in competition
11.	Medicine	The use of computer-assisted training for emergency medical technicians has greatly increased the ability to save lives in the field.	Became a certified EMT; Spent over 400 hours at Whittier Presbyterian
12.	Art	Increased government funding for children's art programs can help combat juvenile delinquency.	Worked as an advocate for children at children's art center
13.	Social Work	Contrary to popular belief, homeless people are victims of circumstances rather than victims of choice.	Went to different locales and conducted interviews with the homeless to find out why/how they became homeless and why these people remained homeless. Ascertained the basic physical needs of the homeless interviewed; Organized a drive to collect goods for distribution among the homeless
14.	Sports	In addition to teaching the fundamental skills of a given sport, the best coaches are experts in employing motivational techniques to create a winning team.	Coached at an after-school soccer clinic for neighborhood youth.
